The woman in the photo on the right looks like an older version of the one on the left. Since Mathilda arrived in New York in 1912, she might have had her photograph taken there. Her brother, Gustaf, and her friend Tilda Person, the dressmaker, both lived in New York, so she may have visited there awhile before traveling to Wisconsin.
